Minutes

Refunds/Credits

-Mike is still working on the credits

Registration Fees:

Social Distancing

-A 30 mile restriction has been put into place. Please give Mike H. your locations of tournaments so that he can get them approved. The sooner the better.

-Thank you to Mike B. for getting him a list of locations for fall ball.

-Cares Act: looking to get thermometers and social distancing signs, maybe we could get removable benches.

CCRP:

-Self help needs to be submitted by end of the month

-Would like to have the fencing on all backstops replaced (Tony to get measurements to Mike) as this is a safety concern.

Golf Tournament 10/2/20:

- We have a few teams signed up
- Sponsors are starting to come in
- We do not expect that we will have to cancel it
- We will look into having a COVID-19 waiver (possibly the one from the Rec Council)
- Lisa emailed the registrants from last year along with our coaches

Tournaments:

- Hot Shots Tournament: Weekend of 9/26 & 9/27 for 10U, 12U, 14U & 16/18U
- Fall Classic: Weekend of 10/31 & 11/1 for all age groups more details to follow
- CML End of Season: Weekend of 11/7 & 11/8

-We have several teams signed up for our tournament -Sent 200 flyers out

Background Checks:

-There is a new link to use. If your badge expired before July you need to do a check ASAP. If it expired after July you are grandfathered in until the end of the year.

-USSSA is requiring a background check for each head coach.

Uniforms:

-Drea and Mike shared that uniform fees are no longer a part of the registration fee paid

-We are using the same uniforms year round, not doing a special uniform for the fall (more cost effective)

-There will be a team store for parents to order the items needed

- the store will list what each coach is requiring for the players

- parents can choose not to order new items if what they have still fits, they can choose to order more of an item if they want

- There will not be fittings as sizing charts will be on the link and parents will need to measure their player and order accordingly

- items being sent directly to player

-There are still spare jerseys and some pants that can be used by the rec players or they can choose to order from the team store. See Drea for this

-Uniforms need to be ordered by Wed. 9/26 so that we can have them in by third week in September

-All coaches are to send Drea their roster with players numbers as soon as possible.

CPR:

-The CPR instructor that we had used in previous years passed away. We will need to find a new instructor:

- JJ Lynott is now an instructor maybe he would be able to help us

- As you update your certification please get them to Frank W.

For the Good of the group:

-Hot Shots is two words and we need to be consistent with registering us as the Hot Shots

-We will not be having a mandatory parent meeting. Instead the presentation will be emailed to each coach and parent. They will need to review the presentation with their player and then sign off on the sheet. There will be a link on the last slide for them to click on and then sign the sheet. This must be completed prior to the first game/tournament of the fall season or they will not be able to play. Drea will keep track of this.
